



**Betsy Ross House
239 Arch Street, Philadelphia
Historic District**

The home of America's Most Famous Flagmaker, the Betsy Ross House is located in the heart of historic Philadelphia, just blocks from Independence Hall and the Liberty Bell. The circa-1740 rowhouse is restored to the period around 1777 when Betsy Ross lived and worked there. Visitors learn all about the legendary story of the creation of America's first flag and witness the successful business Betsy ran Colonial Philadelphia's bustling commercial district.

The Betsy Ross House also hosts special events including Betsy Ross' Birthday Bash (January 1 –), Flag Festival Weekend (June 13 – 14), Fourth of July Weekend (July 3 – 5) and Colonial Craft Fair (October 24 – 25).

Pricing: Starts at \$1,500 for summer weekdays, \$2,000 summer weekends, \$4,000 on holiday weekends and up depending on setup needs and space requirements.

Attendance: Varies from 1,500 to 5,000 depending on day and season.

Demographics: Families, kids, tourists, school groups, summer camp programs.

Time: 10am-5pm with extended hours on holidays, special events and first Fridays.
