Located in the heart of Philadelphia's historic district, across from the Liberty Bell and blocks away from Independence Hall, the National Constitution Center and The Independence Visitors Center, The Bourse is Old City's prime lunch destination for tourists, school children, professionals and locals. The Bourse is also the only venue in the historic district where marketing, sampling and promotional tours can take place due to National Park Property regulations.

Food Court includes Asahi Sushi, China Express, Grand Old Cheesesteaks, Sbarro, Salad Works, Flamers, Bain's Deli and more as well as Philadelphia souvenirs, fashions and a movie theatre. Outdoor exposure is also available at the high traffic entrance at 5<sup>th</sup> Street between Market & Chestnut Streets.

**Pricing Range:** Begins at \$1,500 - \$2,500 per day depending on the month, event hours, setup size and logistics.
