Centennial District, Fairmount Park
Philadelphia**

Please Touch Museum at Memorial Hall, Fairmount Park is the children’s museum of Philadelphia and is dedicated to enriching the lives of children by providing learning opportunities through play. Please Touch features six interactive exhibit zones: Roadside Attractions, Flight Fantasy, City Capers, Wonderland, River Adventures, and Centennial Exploration, along with three toddler areas for the three and under set, daily activities and theater performances. Also on site are a kid-friendly café and the Kids’ Store. Highlights include a century-old fully refurbished Woodside Park Dentzel Carousel and a 40-foot replica of the Statue of Liberty Arm & Torch, made entirely of toys. In October 2008 the new Please Touch Museum opened in Fairmount Park’s Memorial Hall, a National Historic Landmark and 156,000 square foot facility with plenty of parking.
